

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Competition will be run in accordance with British Riding Clubs Rules for Competitions 2009

The judges' decision is final

Entry is open to all Riding Clubs in Area 17

Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not must wear a hard hat with the harness properly adjusted and fastened. Hats marked BS/EN 1384, PASO15 or prefixed with ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard allowed.

All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

Prize winners will be expected to attend the prize giving mounted and correctly dressed.

Each horse must have a valid vaccination certificate which complies with The Vaccination procedure in the current Riding Club Rule book.

The organisers of this competition have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everybody at the event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and to obey instructions by stewards. The riding club accepts no liability for any accident, damage or loss howsoever caused.

Solent Riding Club, Hampshire Horse Shows and people acting on their behalf do not accept any liability for any loss, accident, or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or goods that occurs in connection with this event. It is a condition of entry that each competitor indemnifies the organiser against any claim.

All competitors must bring the vaccination certificate (and passport if the record is spread over two documents) to this event. Under penalty of elimination the competitor is responsible for producing it on demand.
